Purpose: The Saginaw County Community Action Committee, Inc., known as the CAC, is the Community Action Agency (CAA) for Saginaw County operating a multi-purpose center. CAA's, defined in both state and federal law, are formed by local communities to address the barriers to self-sufficiency encountered by low income citizens. CAA's bring together local citizens, including low-income persons, to provide the community with a voice regarding the opportunities that will best help to provide self-sufficiency and productivity for the individual and the community. The CAC is a local decision maker, linking community residents, the systematic assessment of local needs, community-wide response, and service delivery.

Meet: Third Thursday of the month, 5:00 p.m. at CAC Center (subject to change.)

Membership: The Board consists of fifteen members. One-third (five) members shall be from the public sector, one-third (five) members from the private sector and one-third (five) members are representatives of the poor. - That month or the month after receiving said names for each expiring term, the **Chair announces the 3 names that have been placed into nomination, and thereby conducts a roll call vote**, with each commissioner naming his/her choice.
- If a majority vote is cast for one nominee, that nominee is appointed. If no nominee receives a majority vote, voting either concludes or a re-vote can be conducted. Once it is obvious that no nominee will receive a majority vote, a motion to decline the nominees would be in order, as the BOC’s statutory obligations would have been fulfilled. The BOC’s decline of the 3 names must then be communicated to HealthSource so it can submit 3 additional nominees.
