**PARENTING TIME PROCEDURES EFFECTIVE JUNE 1, 2002**

See the attached affidavit if you have been denied parenting time and/or the other party has violated the parenting time Order. You must complete the accompanying form (follow all directions or no action can be taken) and return it to the Friend of the Court. The first step of the enforcement process is to go to mediation to attempt to resolve the parenting time dispute. If mediation is unsuccessful, the matter will proceed to a parenting time enforcement hearing. You will receive a notice of hearing in the mail and you **MUST ATTEND THE HEARING**. Bring any evidence or witnesses necessary to support your position. **IF YOU MAKE ANY FALSE STATEMENTS OR IF THE MATTER IS FILED FRIVOLOUSLY, YOU CAN BE ASSESSED A COURT FEE OF A MINIMUM OF \$150.00**. If you prevail and the other party is found to be at fault or to have acted frivolously, he/she can be assessed a fee which shall be a minimum of \$150.00.

It is still possible to petition to modify parenting time, custody, and domicile Orders. There will be a fee charged (as determined by the Friend of the Court) for this service.
