

**PETITION REGARDING CHANGE OF DOMICILE/RESIDENCE  
SAGINAW COUNTY FRIEND OF THE COURT  
FORM 60**

**Use this Petition if:**

- You have a Judgment of Divorce or Separate Maintenance or an Order of Filiation which places restrictions on changing the domicile/residence of the minor child(ren) and you wish to petition the Court for a change in these provisions.

**You cannot use this form:**

- To start a custody case; or
- If you are a third party and want to intervene to get custody of the child(ren) in a pending case for custody, divorce, separate maintenance, or paternity.

If both parties agree to a change in the Order no Petition is necessary. If an agreement is reached please notify your Caseworker in writing indicating the specifics of the agreement. Both parties **MUST** sign the written statement.

FILING THIS PETITION WILL RESULT IN THE FRIEND OF THE COURT CONDUCTING AN INVESTIGATION. PRIOR TO AN INVESTIGATION BEING DONE THE PETITIONING PARTY MUST PAY A **MINIMUM INVESTIGATION FEE OF \$150.00 TO THE FRIEND OF THE COURT. PLEASE PAY BY MONEY ORDER PAYABLE TO THE FRIEND OF THE COURT AND DESIGNATED "CASEWORKER INVESTIGATION FEE".**

IF IT IS DECIDED THAT A CONTRACTUAL PERSON MUST INVESTIGATE YOUR CASE YOU WILL BE NOTIFIED OF ANY ADDITIONAL COST.

**IF YOU HAVE FILED AN AFFIDAVIT FOR  
SUSPENSION OF FILING FEES DUE TO  
INDIGENCY AND THE FILING FEES HAVE  
BEEN WAIVED, YOU STILL MUST PAY THE  
\$150 "CASEWORKER INVESTIGATION FEE"**

This packet is prepared in accordance to the guidelines of the State Court Administrator's Office Forms.

## PETITION CHECKLIST

Use the following checklist to make sure you have done all the steps that are included.

### **DID YOU...READ THE INSTRUCTIONS FIRST?**

1. Fill out all requested information on the Petition? YES
2. Make all the necessary copies? YES
3. Pay the Petition fee to the Circuit Court Clerk? YES   
(located in the basement of the Courthouse). When you filed the original petition with the Circuit Court Clerk, ask for the copies of the petition to be stamped (True Copy).
4. Mail (serve) a copy of the Petition on the other party YES
5. Return to the Clerk's office **after** you mailed the Petition and completed the certificate of mailing? YES
6. Keep one copy of the Petition for yourself? YES
7. Give 1 copy of the completed Petition to the YES   
Circuit Court Court with the completed Certificate of Mailing?
8. Deliver 1 copy of the completed Petition to the YES   
Friend of the Court with the completed Certificate of Mailing?
9. Pay the Friend of the Court Investigation fee? YES

If you cannot answer "YES" to all of the above steps, your Petition may be delayed or your Petition may be dismissed.

By using this Petition packet you are representing yourself in a Court action regarding change of domicile/residence. In order to receive the action you seek, you must follow the instructions in this packet. If you fail to do even one of the required steps, the Order you get from the Court may not give you the relief you want.

**If you have any question about any steps in the process, refer to page 3 through 5 of this packet for details.**

**The Friend of the Court does NOT represent either party. In preparation for the Investigation, each party is encouraged to review the CHILD CUSTODY ACT, which may be obtained from the state court administrator's office (989-373-8289) or the public library. The Friend of the Court is NOT authorized to give the parties legal advice or to assist in filing this Petition. Either party may hire an attorney during any point in the process.**

# INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILING A PETITION

## ⇔ FILING A PETITION

### 1. Fill out the Petition.

Use the document on page 6. Use the instruction on page 5. Since there is only an original of the Petition in this packet, type or print neatly, using a black or blue pen. Be careful to not make mistakes. (THIS IS A COURT DOCUMENT)

**Make at least 4 copies of the Petition after you have filled it out.**

### 2. File the Petition form with the Circuit Court Clerk (located in the basement of the Courthouse).

Take the original and 4 copies of the Petition to the Circuit Court Clerk.

You must pay a \$100.00 either in the form of a money order, cash or personal check (not a starter check) made payable to the "Clerk of the Court" (\$20.00 is for the **Motion Fee** and \$80.00 is the fee for entry of the **Order**).

The Clerk will keep the original true copy of the Petition and any attachments for the Court file and stamp "True Copy" on all other copies. You **MUST** provide the Friend of the Court with a true copy of your Petition. Do not lose your remaining true copies of your Petition.

What you should have when you leave the Clerk's office:

- 1 Copy of the Petition (with any attachments)- for you
- 1 Copy of the Petition (with any attachments)- for the other party
- 1 Copy of the Petition (with any attachments)- for the Court
- 1 Copy of the Petition-(with any attachments)- the Friend of the Court

### 3. **An investigation fee of \$150.00 will be assessed by the Friend of the Court. You must pay the fee prior to the Friend of the Court beginning an investigation. This payment must be made by money order made payable to the Saginaw County Friend of the Court and designated as "Investigation fee". IF IT IS DECIDED THAT A CONTRACTUAL PERSON MUST INVESTIGATE YOUR CASE YOU WILL BE NOTIFIED OF ANY ADDITIONAL COST.**

### 4. **You must ensure that the address for both parties is the address on file with the Friend of the Court. If you fail to provide the correct address for either party your Petition may be dismissed for lack of service.**

# INSTRUCTIONS FOR SERVING A PETITION

## ⇔ SERVING THE PETITION ON THE OTHER PARTY OR PARTIES

### 1. **Serve the Petition on the other party.**

**YOU MUST SERVE (NOTIFY BY MAIL)** the other party prior to the Friend of the Court reviewing the Petition. **You CANNOT hand deliver the papers to the other party.**

#### **What you need for service:**

- 1 Copy of the Petition (with any attachments)- with the completed certificate of mailing for you
- 1 Copy of the Petition (with any attachments)- with the completed certificate of mailing for the other party
- 1 Copy of the Petition (with any attachments)- with the completed certificate of mailing for the Court
- 1 Copy of the Petition (with any attachments)- with the completed certificate of mailing for the Friend of the Court

Fill out the Certificate of Mailing (date and sign) on all copies of the Petition. Mail one copy to the other party.

**NOTE:** Serve the papers by mailing them to the other party by regular, first class mail. **THE DATE ON THE CERTIFICATE OF MAILING MUST BE THE DATE YOU MAILED THE PETITION TO THE OTHER PARTY.**

### 2. **Return to the Circuit Court Clerk**

Once you have mailed the Petition to the other party return to the Circuit Court Clerk's office. You will have three copies with the completed certificate of mailing. Give the Circuit Court Clerk one copy for the Court file. Keep 1 copy for your own records. Deliver 1 copy to the Friend of the Court. You **MUST** deliver a copy directly to the Friend of the Court office.

### 3. **Response from the other party.**

If you receive a response to your Petition from the other party make sure you read it.

## INSTRUCTION FOR COMPLETING “PETITION REGARDING CHANGE OF DOMICILE/RESIDENCE”

**Please print neatly. After filling in the Petition, you will need to make at least 5 copies.**

Items A through J must be completed before your Petition can be filed with the Court. Please read the instruction for each of item. Then fill in the correct information for that item on the Petition.

- A. Before you fill in the Case No., get your Court papers for divorce, separate maintenance, or paternity and copy the Case No. from those Court papers onto this Petition form.
- B. Also use your Court paper to fill in the “Plaintiff” and the “Defendant” boxes. Copy the names from these court papers onto this Petition. For example, if your name is in the box that says “Plaintiff” on the original court document, then you should write your name in the “Plaintiff” box on this Petition form.

You are the “moving party” and the burden of proving why you should be granted the requested relief lies with you. Once you have written both names where they belong, you must check the box “moving party” in the same box as your name.

You must ensure that the address for both parties is the address on file with the Friend of the Court and if you do not know the address you must verify the address with the Friend of the Court.

- C. **Check only one box.** If you have a judgment or order for custody, separate maintenance, or paternity, read it carefully to find out if there is any information in it about custody. If there is information about custody check box a. If there is no information about custody check box b.
- D. Check this box only if you checked box a. in C. above. Read your Court papers for custody, divorce, separate maintenance, or paternity to find out who was order to have custody. Write this information here along with the name(s) of the child(ren).
- E. State who the child(ren) are living with now, the address or location where the child(ren), and the date the child(ren) started living there even if it is different than what was ordered.
- F. State the circumstances that require a custody order or a change in custody. **Explain in as much detail** as possible what has happened. If you need more space, use a separate sheet of paper. Print this information as neatly as you can. You will need 4 copies of this sheet to attach to 4 copies of the Petition.
- G. State the causes that require a custody order or a change in custody. The Friend of the Court will review these causes using the factors from the Child Custody Act to determine the best interests of the child. **Explain in as much detail** as possible what the causes are. If you need more space, use a separate sheet of paper. Print this information as neatly as you can. You will need 4 copies of this sheet to attach to 4 copies of this Petition.
- H. Check this box if you and the other party agree about custody. Explain in as much detail as possible what you agreed to including parenting time. If you need more space, use a separate sheet of paper. Print this information as neatly as you can. You will need 4 copies of this sheet to attach to the copies of this Petition.
- I. You need to explain in as much detail as possible what you want the Court to order. If you checked H. above, you only need to write: Same as 4 above”. If you need more space, use a separate sheet of paper. You need to include information about parenting time as well. Print this information as neatly as you can. You will need 4 copies of this sheet to attach to copies of this Petition.
- J. Write in today’s date and sign your name.
