

NOTICE OF CHANGE

At the November 16th board meeting, the Board of Commissioners amended County Ordinance #114, The Soil Erosion and Sedimentation Control Ordinance. In regards to changing the fees charged for required SESC permits **effective January 1, 2011.**

The changes are as follow:

1. Submission of application for approvalfrom \$40.00 to \$60.00
2. Plan review (per acre and fraction of for acre disturbed)from \$40.00 to \$60.00
3. Revised plan review (per acre)from \$15.00 to \$20.00
4. Site Inspection (Per acre and fraction of for acre disturbed) ..from\$40.00 to \$60.00
5. Request for time extension – administrative fee..... from \$40.00 to \$60.00
6. Re-inspection fee (per occurrence)from \$40.00 to \$60.00
7. Minor use, under 1 acre from \$60.00 to \$90.00
8. General Subdivision Lot from \$100.00 to \$150.00
9. Bond minimum of 2 acres..... \$400 per acre (no change)


If a regulated activity is started prior to obtaining a permit all cost are doubled and violators are subject to receiving a civil infraction (ticket). Civil infractions are 1st offense \$100, second offense \$500, third infraction \$2500 and a flagrant infraction is subject to restitution of the sight and a \$10,000 fine.

Permit forms may be downloaded from www.saginawcounty.com select departments and select Public Works – Drain Division.

If your activity covers over 5 acres a state notice of coverage is also required from the DNRE. Although once you have a permit from the Public Works Office and send in the notice of coverage to the state, you are free to start the earth change.
