Re: Dangerous Flooding along Tittabawassee River

Just before 6:00 p.m. on 5-19-2020, the Edenville Dam on the Tittabawassee River failed. Failure of the Sanford Dam is imminent. Residents along the Tittabawassee River in Saginaw County will be impacted by these dam failures.

The Freeland, Tittabawassee, and State St. Bridges over the Tittabawassee River will be closed.

Residents who live in the following areas should make plans for a rapid increase in floodwaters.

- Residents on the Tittabawassee River in Tittabawassee, Saginaw, and Thomas Twps.
- Residents in the Freeland Mobile Home Park
- Residents in the Robin Meadows/Thornberry/Creston areas of Tittabawassee Twp.

Temporary shelters are being set up at the following locations for those needing to evacuate:

East of the River

West of the River

Swan Valley High School
8400 O'Hern

Hemlock High School
