III. Project Overview

- The project is being bid in two divisions (Division I and Division II). Each division has a separate set of plans and bidding documents. Each Division will be awarded separately.
- Pump Station Division I
 - o Existing Conditions Sheet 5 (G2)
 - o Proposed Conditions Sheet 7 (C1)
- Open Channel Division II
 - \circ Drain maintenance and drain construction involving various levels of excavation and clearing on 2.5 +/- Miles of open drain
 - o Replacement of 2 road crossings and 1 road cross culvert
 - o Replacement of 6 private crossings
 - o Installation of 1 new crossing
 - o Removal of 1 existing crossings (without replacement)
 - o Installation of soil erosion and sedimentation control measures.
 - o Curtis Road Road shoulder improvements (Bishop to Ambrose)

- Notice to Proceed Estimated to be near the end of August 2023
- Substantial Completion: October 1st, 2024
- Final Completion: October 31st, 2024
- Liquidated Damages \$500.00 per day from substantial completion date.
- The project is partially grant funded and the grant has to be spent in 2023. We are requesting that all materials are ordered this year at a minimum, so grant funds can be expended.

V. Special Project Considerations

Entire Project (Applies to Both Divisions)

- Project Coordination

- Basis of Payment & Measurement
 - o Basis of Payment and Measurement for each bid item is provided in the specifications and should be reviewed in detail by all bidders.
 - o Bid Items are based on local standards and vary from MDOT standard specifications.
 - All work shown in plans is intended to be included in the bid items on the bid form. If there are questions on how work items are being paid for, inquire with Spicer Group and we will provide clarifications as needed.

<u>Pump Station – Division I</u>

- Inspection days are being bid out. See bid form for additional details. Spicer Group Inspection A Spicer Inspector will be required to be on site for the following activities:
 - o Laying pipe
 - o Backfilling trenches
 - o Exploratory Excavation/Utility Location
 - Wet well manhole installation
 - o Installation of pumps
 - o Installation of bar screen
 - o Installation of pre-cast concrete headwall and footings
 - o Pouring Concrete
 - o Equipment Startups
- Existing pumps, motors, discharge pipes, flapgates and electrical components are to be salvaged and delivered to RC Heritage Farms barn yard on Curtis Road.
- Site can be accessed from either side of drain at the intersection of Curtis and Bishop. Permissions from USFW for north side will be obtained prior to construction.
- Soil borings have been obtained and are included in the geotechnical report included in Appendix A of the specifications.
- An EGLE permit has been obtained and is included in Appendix B of the specifications. Stipulations in permit must be followed as noted.
- Information related to the proposed pumps can be found in Appendix C of the specifications.
- All invoices from utility companies for new services at the pump station will be paid by the owner. The contractor will be responsible for scheduling and coordination with the utility companies.

- Alternate Bid item for 20" discharge pipes and flapgates in lieu of 24" discharge pipes and flapgates
 - Award of alternate bid item will be based on pricing provided by contractor.

Open Channel – Division II

- Owner to supply pipes to be installed at Crossing No. 2. Bid item is for installation only. The pipe material is salvaged RCP from a previous project.
 Owner to deliver pipe to site, contractor to unload.
- Contractor to use spoils from open channel construction to improve road shoulders along Curtis Road from Bishop Road to Ambrose Road as shown on plans.
- Remaining spoils from open channel construction are to be hauled to stockpile site on USFW property. Contractor to coordinate with USFW prior to stockpiling.
- Spoils in all other areas are to be leveled along drain in right of way as shown in plans.
- An EGLE permit has been obtained and is included in Appendix A of the specifications.
- Division II contains Alternate Bid Items for CMP crossing replacements in lieu of HP Storm.
 - o All costs for these crossings are to be included in the Alternate Bid items for each crossing.
 - o Award of alternate bid item will be based on pricing provided by contractor.

VI. Payment

• Owner shall make progress payments on account of the Contract Price on the basis of Contractor's Applications for Payment on or about the 25th day of each month during performance of the Work.

VII. Construction Staking and Inspection

- Staking OWNER will provide through the ENGINEER all construction staking for the project.
- Spicer Group Inspection A Spicer Inspector will be required to be on site as noted above.

VIII. Permits

- Owner has obtained EGLE permits required.
- No soil erosion permit is required.
- Contractor is responsible for obtaining any additional required permits from local agencies. (road commission, etc.)
- Permit costs will be reimbursed to contractor based on actual invoiced amounts.
- All permit stipulations must be met by contractor.

- Contractor to maintain access to roads and driveways outside of working hours.
- Contractor to coordinate temporary road shutdowns with landowners and owner of road as necessary.
