Membership: MALPH's purpose is to unify public health in Michigan. Unique in the Nation, the Michigan Association for Local Public Health was founded in 1985 as a private, non-profit, 501-C3 state association. The Association is organized to represent Michigan's 45 city, county, and district health departments before the state and federal legislative and executive branches of government. Each local health department has one (1) vote on the MALPH Board of Directors. Saginaw County appoints a primary voting member and a permanent alternate who may vote only in the absence of the primary member. It is recommended that the Health Officer and a jurisdictional (*County Commissioner or Board of Health member*) fill the primary and alternate positions. Either the health officer or the jurisdictional member may be designated as the primary voting member. Appointed by the Board Chair.
