

NOTICE OF ELECTION SAGINAW COUNTY, MICHIGAN TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 7, 2023, SPECIAL ELECTION

To the Qualified Electors of the Montrose Community Schools District

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that a Special Election will be held in all precincts in the Montrose Community Schools District on Tuesday, November 7, 2023. The polls will be open from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. at the following polling locations:

MAPLE GROVE TOWNSHIP Precinct 1 - Township Hall, 17010 Lincoln Rd.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the qualified electors of the Montrose Community Schools District will vote on the following proposals and any other proposals that may appear on the ballot at that time:

Montrose Community Schools Bond Proposal - Shall Montrose Community Schools, Genesee and Saginaw Counties, Michigan, borrow the sum of not to exceed Fifteen Million Nine Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$15,900,000) and issue its general obligation unlimited tax bonds therefor, in one or more series, for the purpose of: erecting, furnishing, and equipping additions to the middle school building; remodeling, furnishing and refurnishing, and equipping and re-equipping school buildings and facilities; acquiring and installing instructional technology in school buildings; preparing, developing, improving, erecting, and equipping athletic fields and facilities; and preparing, developing, improving, and equipping playgrounds and sites? The following is for informational purposes only: The estimated millage that will be levied for the proposed bonds in 2024, under current law, is -0- mills (\$0.00 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a -0- mill net increase over the prior year's levy. The maximum number of years the bonds of any series may be outstanding, exclusive of any refunding, is twenty-eight (28) years. The estimated simple average annual millage anticipated to be required to retire this bond debt is 2.49 mills (\$2.49 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation). The school district expects to borrow from the State School Bond Qualification and Loan Program to pay debt service on these bonds. The estimated total principal amount of that borrowing is \$7,711,658 and the estimated total interest to be paid thereon is \$5,820,788. The estimated duration of the millage levy associated with that borrowing is 24 years and the estimated computed millage rate for such levy is 7.00 mills. The estimated computed millage rate may change based on changes in certain circumstances. The total amount of qualified bonds currently outstanding is \$2,094,567. (Pursuant to State law, expenditure of bond proceeds must be audited and the proceeds cannot be used for repair or maintenance costs, teacher, administrator, or employee salaries, or other

All polling locations are accessible for voters with disabilities.
