Summer is in full swing in your Saginaw County Parks! I'm hopeful that you've had time to experience and explore summertime in Michigan, including right here in Saginaw County. Whether on a bike or hike on one of our beautiful trail systems or beating the heat at William H. Haithco Recreation Area, there's opportunity for all to recreate in Saginaw County. The cooler Memorial Day temperatures had us wondering if summer would ever come, but here we are in July! Looking back, June saw near-record patron numbers at Haithco Recreation Area, with over 6000 vehicle entries and over 21,000 patrons last month alone. We couldn't be happier that the parks are well-utilized, and I would be remiss if I didn't call out another absolutely fantastic staff team working hard for patrons this season. Thirty-three individuals have joined our six full-time staff for the summer to help us to cultivate and maintain safe, clean, and fun Saginaw County Parks.

And they're doing just that, welcoming well over 1000 park patrons at William H. Haithco Recreation Area on some of our busiest days, to hosting a great family fishing festival with over 220 youth participants, 150 on our semiannual senior rail trail rides, and hosting over 150 group rentals under our park pavilions so far this summer, celebrating birthdays, baby showers, high school or family reunions, graduation parties, and more. This simply wouldn't be possible without the dedicated folks working 7 days a week in your Saginaw County Parks all summer long. Please join me in thanking this incredible staff team!

Are you looking for a location for your special outing? We have the perfect place for any occasion! Pavilion reservations are ideal for company picnics, family or school reunions, graduation parties, birthday parties, church groups, clubs and any group that would appreciate having their outing in a beautiful Saginaw County Park. The William H. Haithco Recreation Area provides modern bathrooms, playgrounds, Ruth Averill Splash Pad, fishing docks, volleyball courts and five picnic pavilions. Imerman Memorial Park provides modern bathrooms, a fishing dock, a volleyball court, a playground, horseshoe pits, basketball and tennis courts, an inline hockey rink, Bark Park and four picnic pavilions.

We begin accepting 2025 pavilion reservations for the William H. Haithco Recreation Area, Imerman Memorial Park, and Price Nature Center on January 2, 2025.

Pavilion rental fees are \$75 per day for Saginaw County Residents. Park entry for Saginaw County Residents is free. Non Residents pay a \$2.00 per vehicle entry fee at Imerman Memorial Park and a \$5.00 per vehicle entry fee at the William H. Haithco Recreation Area (Memorial Day weekend thru Labor Day).
